Oral health and Healthy Smiles accreditation:



Every Early Years provider must promote good health, including oral health, for children attending the setting. Two years ago, we took part in obtaining the Healthy Smiles accreditation and this is now due for renewal so to complete this new accreditation, we will need to achieve certain standards, which we will be able to do only with your support. Each week we are going to work with children on themerelated activities and also give children homework to complete at home and bring it back to collect as evidence. We will also promote oral health by posting the related material on our Facebook page regularly and we hope you will support our efforts.

Next term we would like to start with our Woodland Walks and during some sessions take the children on educational walks around the village. However, this would require higher adult: child ratios so we are looking for parents to come along and help us to supervise children. If you are interested, please let us know.
